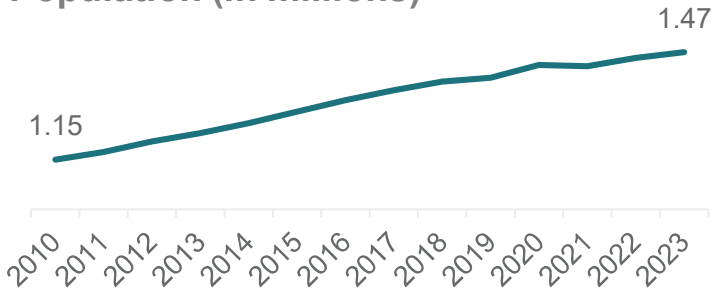
UNBELIEVABLY REAL



Orange County is the region's most populous county and includes the City of Orlando, as well as 12 other incorporated cities. The county sits in the approximate center of the state, midway between Jacksonville and Miami. Well known for its simulation, optics/photonics and high-tech sectors, Orange County is home to the second largest university in the nation, one of the top ten research parks in the country, one of only two national entrepreneur centers, a world-class international airport and Lake Nona Medical City.

Population (in millions)



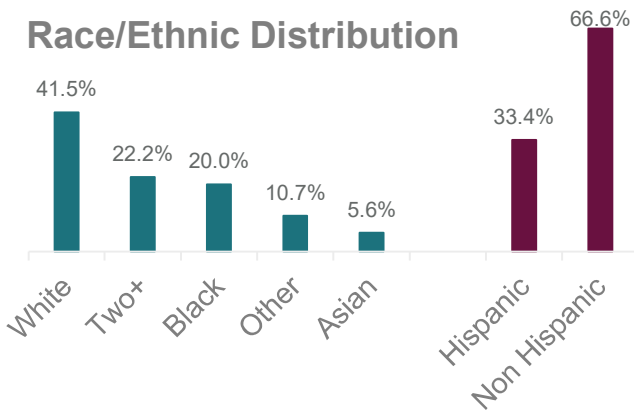

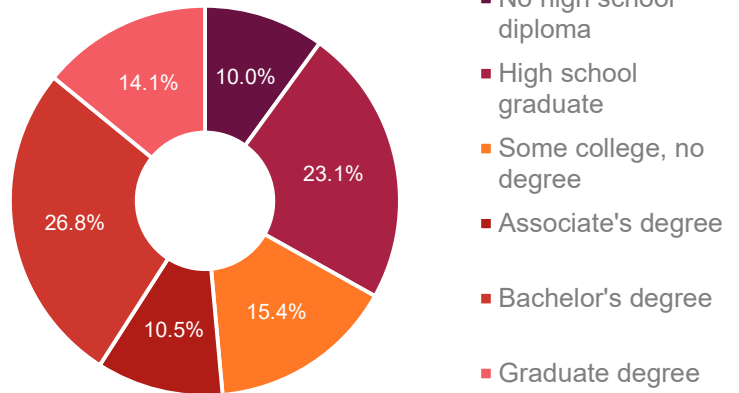

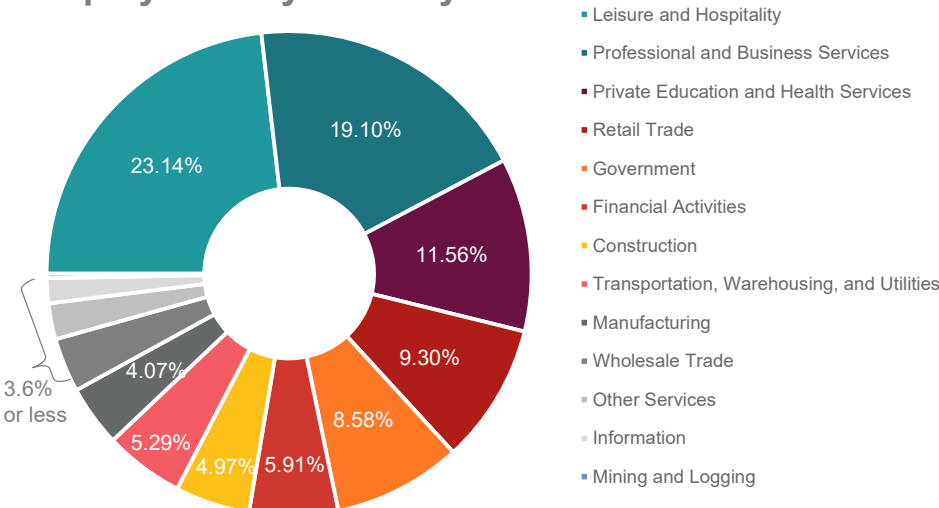
Educational Attainment

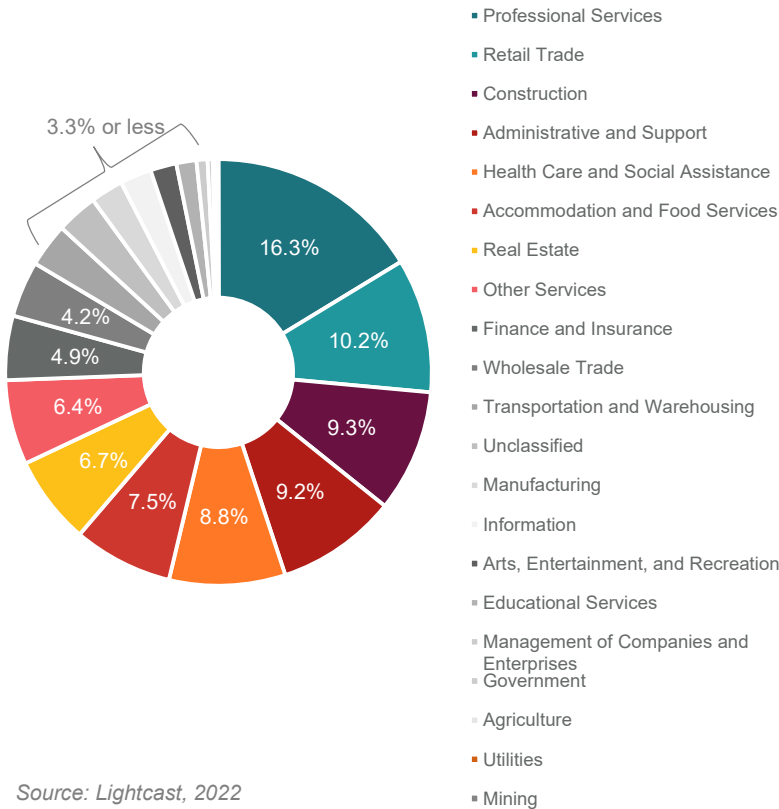
