




Unemployment Rate, Orlando MSA

Seasonally Adjusted






New Claims for Unemployment Insurance, Orlando MSA 12-Month Moving Average

Average Weekly Hours & Earnings, Orlando MSA 12-Month Moving Average



Total, Nonfarm Payroll Employment, Orlando MSA Seasonally Adjusted








Net Job Gain, Orlando MSANot Seasonally Adjusted, Thousands






Employment Momentum by Florida MSA/MD March 2020, Seasonally Adjusted





Industrial Market, Orlando MSA





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



Home Sales vs. Median Sales Price Orlando MSA



Orlando MSA Retail Index






