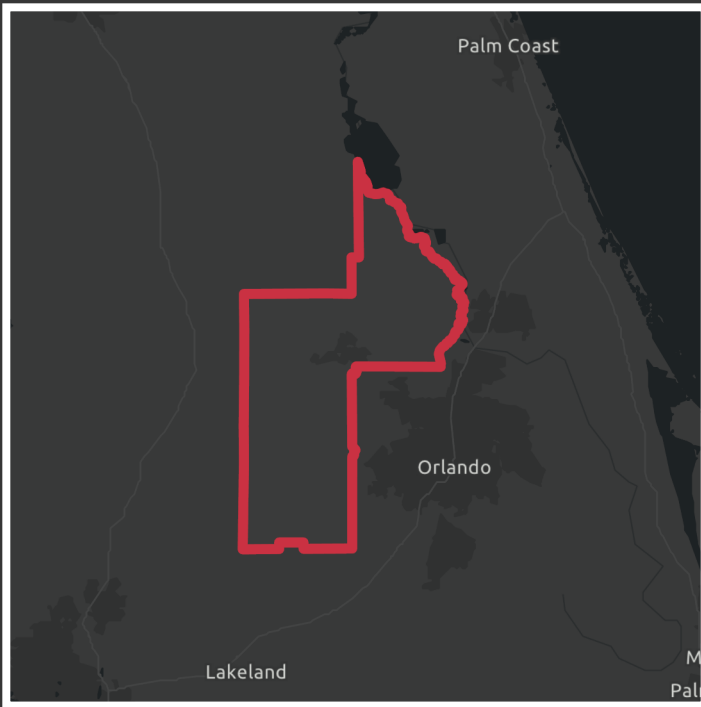

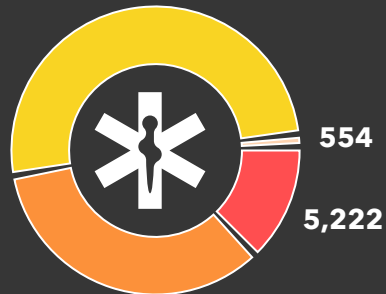

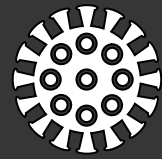

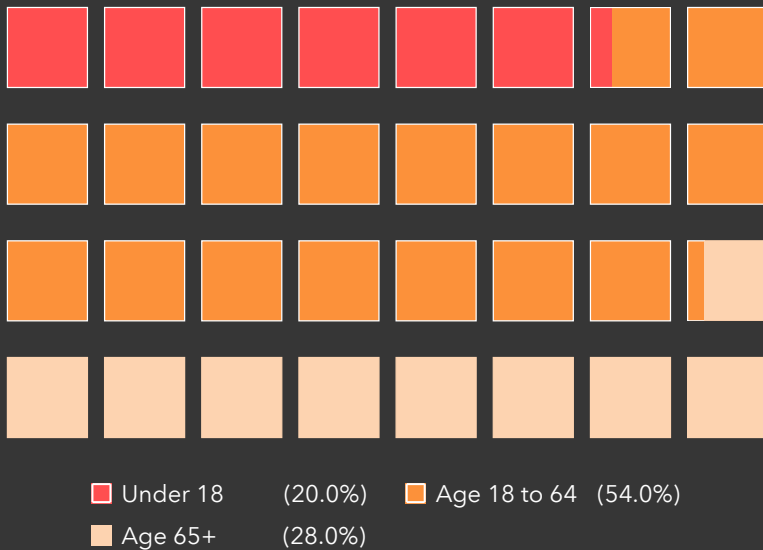

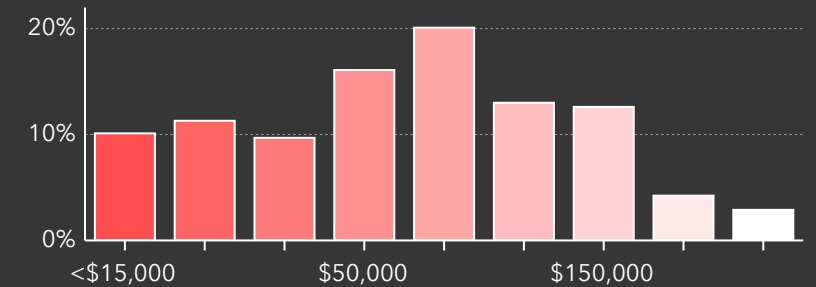

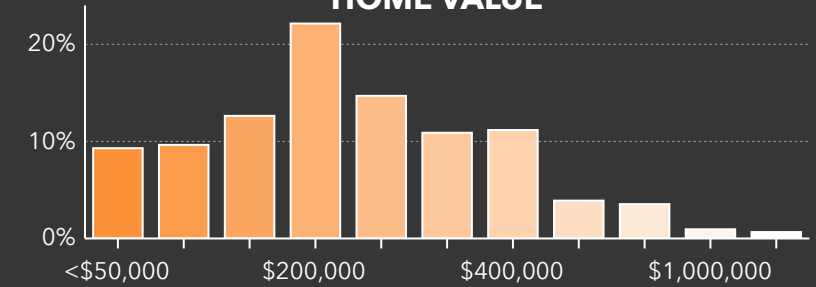
POPULATION BY AGE
